Frequently Asked Questions

Am I eligible to receive homebound delivery services?

To receive services, you must be a homebound resident of Madison County and unable to visit the library due to physical disability, chronic illness, or age-related issues.

You also need a library card in good standing to receive services. If you do not currently have a library card, we can sign you up for one.

How do I sign up?

Fill out an Application for Homebound Delivery Service and return it to the library by email, fax, or regular mail. Applications are available at each library or online at: www.mcls.ms/Bookmobile/Homebound.pdf

What can I borrow?

- Books - regular or large print
- AudioBooks on CD
- DVD's

Will I get materials I like?

Items will be selected according to your suggestions and the areas of interest you indicate on your application. You can also request specific items.

How often will you visit?

Once a month. When your application is approved, we will contact you to establish a delivery schedule.

How long may I borrow the items you bring me?

Checkout periods for delivered materials are four weeks. Materials may be renewed unless on hold for another patron.

Is there a charge?

There is a no charge to participate, if eligible. Because we schedule pick-up of materials, there are no overdue fines.

However, you are responsible for the care of library materials and for ensuring they are available at the scheduled pickup time and location. If you lose or damage materials, you will be charged the cost of the items.
